


SRC ONLINE LEARNING

- There is an online learning component of the SRC course.
- The modules will take about 45mins to complete
- To access the online material you will need to do 2 things
 - 1. Create an SLSA Portal Account
 - 2. Enrol in the SRC online training module
- This guide shows you how to do this=

1. CREATE AN SLSA PORTAL ACCOUNT

- Go to https://members.sls.com.au/SLSA_Online/modules/login/index.php



- **Each rookie will need to login under their own account** (not a family or parent account – which will already be setup if parent is a patrolling member)
- Click on “**Don't have a members account yet**”
- Enter First Name, Last Name and DOB
- Then choose a username and password
- *As long as the First Name, Last Name and DOB match the club registration records, this should work*

- **If there are any problems, let us know and we can help get this fixed**


